KEWAUNEE

LICENSED VARIETY

Kewaunee is a six-rowed, smooth-awned variety that was released by the University of Wisconsin-Madison in 1997. Kewaunee is very high-yielding as shown in Wisconsin statewide trials. Kewaunee has good test weight, lodging resistance, and resistance to leaf rust, stem rust, powdery mildew and stem blotch. Kewaunee heads about the same time as Chilton, and is approximately the same height as Hazen and Robust. Kewaunee is a feed barley.

Kewaunee is a U.S. Plant Protected Variety (PVPA 1994). Seed of Kewaunee can legally be produced and labeled for sale only as certified seed by growers who have been licensed by the Wisconsin Crop Improvement Association or its legal agent.

PINNACLE

LICENSED VARIETY

Pinnacle is a malting variety that was released by North Dakota Agricultural Experiment station in 2008. Pinnacle is a two-rowed, smooth-awned, long rachilla, white aleurone and plump seeded variety with some drought resistance. It has spot blotch resistance that approaches that of Lacey and Drummond.

Pinnacle is a U.S. Plant Protected Variety (PVPA 1994). Seed of this variety can only be sold as a class of certified seed. A license is required for seed production.

QUEST

LICENSED VARIETY

Quest is a six-rowed malting barley variety released by the Minnesota Agricultural Experimental Station in 2010. Quest is a semi-smooth awned variety and has yield and grain protein levels similar to Lacey and Tradition. Quest is about the same height as Robust, but taller than Lacey and has white aleurone and long rachilla hair. Quest has Fusarium head blight resistance and low mycotoxin (DON) levels.

Quest is a U.S. Plant Protected Variety (PVPA 1994), Title V. A license is required for seed production.

RASMUSSEN

LICENSED VARIETY

Rasmusson is a high yielding malting variety with improved malting quality characteristics released by Minnesota Agricultural Experiment Station in 2008. It is a six-rowed, smooth-awned, white aleurone variety with good kernel plumpness. Rasmusson is shorter than most current six-rowed malting varieties in the Midwest with good lodging resistance. It is similar to Robust for scab reaction and is resistant to spot blotch.

Rasmusson is a U.S. Plant Protected Variety (PVPA 1994). Seed of Rasmusson can legally be produced and labeled for sale only as a class of certified seed. A license is required for seed production.
