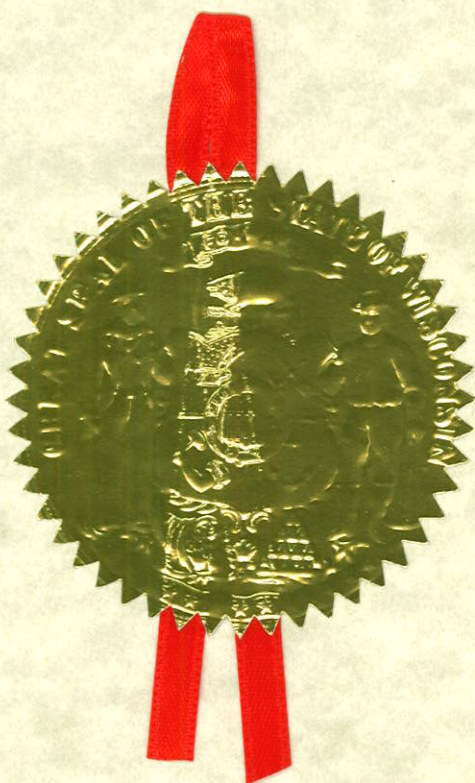


*NOW, THEREFORE*, I, Scott Walker, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, do hereby proclaim March 31, 2011 to be
